Established in 1989; it was initiated by Arizona's Sandy LaBauve, the program was formed to connect girls between the ages 7 to 17 with the game of golf. Today the national program brings young girls to learn the game and strengthen the camaraderie among participants in a fun and supportive environment with nearly 6,000 girls participating this year.

Here in Phoenix, thanks to Kathy, the program meets year-round with weekly events in the summer and monthly events during the school year. The tournament formats include scramble, best-ball, team outings, parent/daughter and evening glow ball events. The variety of formats allow the emphasis to be placed on having fun and encourage family involvement.

### Champagne Classic Format: Cha Cha Cha

In the Cha Cha Cha tournament format, each member of the team plays her ball throughout.

But a 3-hole rotation exists for determining how many scores are used to create the team score.

On the first hole (cha), the one low ball counts as the team score. On the second hole (cha cha), the two low balls count as the team score. On the third hole (cha cha cha), the three low balls count as the team score. The rotation starts over on the fourth hole.

1 ball: holes # 1, 4, 7, 10, 13, 16

2 balls: holes # 2, 5, 8, 11, 14, 17

3 balls: holes # 3, 6, 9, 12, 15, 18

Unless your ball will be used, you may pick up at any time!

**Mulligans:** If you have purchased your Mulligans, you may use one on each side.

**Special Events:** Because we have a full field of fabulous gals, we've provided a few "Special Events" in case there's a slowdown...it's always fun to have something to look forward to!
